The Women's Cell of Sri Ramkrishna Sarada Vidyamahapitha has organized a state-level webinar on 12th March, 2021 under the aegis of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell of the institution. The purpose of the webinar was to explore the questions concerning gender in the new India. The webinar began at 10:30 am with the welcome address delivered by Mrs. Bhaswati Basu, Assistant Professor and Head, Department of Philosophy and member of the Women's Cell. In her welcome address, Mrs. Basu has explained the relevance of such endeavour conducted by the Women's Cell. Her address was followed by the inaugural speech of Dr. Mousumi Ghosh, the Principal of Sri Ramkrishna Sarada Vidyamahapitha. In her inaugural address, Dr. Ghosh has set the tone of the conference by providing references from various texts and stressed on the necessity to develop gender sensitization in the campuses of the academic institutions.

The first speaker of the webinar was Mr. Sayan Chatterjee, PhD Research Scholar, Department of English, University of North Bengal. Mr. Chatterjee has made a theoretical discourse on gender and/as performance. Drawing on the theories of Toril Moi, Judith Butler and Eve Sedgwick, he has shown the Problematisation of gender, sex and desire and their interrelationships in the contemporary Gender discourses. The discussion was followed by an interactive session with the audiences, especially students.

The second speaker of the session was Mrs. Soma Ghosal, Assistant Professor and Head, Department of Political Science of the institution. Mrs. Ghosal has delivered a comprehensive presentation on various movements of Feminism, violence against women, cyber-crime and various laws concerning security and rights of women. The discussion was followed by a lively interactive session with the audiences.

The presentation by Mrs. Ghosal was followed by two short presentations by Dr Pradipta Shyam Chowdhury, Assistant Professor, Department of English, University of North Bengal

and Mr. Jayanto Ghosh, Assistant Professor and Head, Department of English of the institution. In his short presentation, Mr. Ghosh talked about equality and equity in gender studies. Dr Chowdhury, in spite of his ill health, addresses the audience and raises intriguing questions concerning 'jokes' related to gender binaries.

In the valedictory session, Mr. Tanmoy Pandit, Assistant Professor and Coordinator, IQAC has talked about the necessity of organizing such webinars and the position of women in ancient India. Mrs. Kakali Santra, Assistant Professor, Department of Sanskrit and Convenor, Women's Cell delivered the vote of thanks. Mr. Subham Amin, Assistant Professor, Department of English and Member, Women's Cell conducted the sessions.
